 - We are aware of the need for Pre entry to Entry 2 materials

MONITORING USAGE BY YOUR LEARNERS

Learners can register and set up their own account on the site, and are free to access as many or as few of the resources as they wish.

However, in line with ETF Data Privacy Policy, without their permission the ETF cannot tell other parties, (including their provider) which modules a user has completed or what they have done on the site. This is done to respect privacy as they have enrolled as individuals. If a learner registers themselves on the site then the data that records what they have done belongs to the individual learner and to the Education and Training Foundation.

MONITORING USAGE BY YOUR LEARNERS 2

Many providers will wish to track the progress of individual learners, as well as groups of learners, and we offer two cost-effective services a provider may purchase to enable this to happen:

2. Provider Access System (PAS)
