- Promote training providers and employers

Apprentices are invited to attend a free two-hour online training that will develop their confidence and interpersonal skills. The expectation is that they will be invited to attend an Apprenticeships in Sussex school or community session where the ambassadors' attendance is dependent on their availability and gaining permission to be released from work.
