Eligibility details for 2020/21 starts

To qualify to receive an award your staff must be undertaking a **Level 3 teacher training course**, a **Cert Ed** or a **PGCE** within the 2020-2021 academic year. The maximum possible bursary is £4000.

Eligible candidates must:

1. Be completing a level 3 teacher training qualification a Cert Ed or PGCE within the academic year 2020/21.
2. Teach a specialist vocational area which matches one of the SELEP priority sector areas (see table below)
3. Have their college/ITP agreement to provide £1500 match funding for Cert Ed or PGCE or 50% of the cost of a level 3 qualification.
