


Supporting East Sussex residents, living in supported and temporary accommodation, to secure an apprenticeship or employment, and permanent housing.


The service provides a fun holiday experience during guests respite stays and opportunities to meet new friends. Greenwood is a great caring environment, with lots of great people working together as a team.


