- 1. Demonstrate an awareness of working with people with complex mental health needs OR a willingness to develop this knowledge
- 2. Not essential but some knowledge of safeguarding vulnerable adults would be useful
- 3. Not essential but an awareness of the mental capacity act would be useful

What experience do I need?

You don't need any experience; a full training programme is provided. However, the team is looking for candidates with experience in using IT and an understanding of medication administration procedures is desirable as the role will include the day-to-day management of medication.
