What is the job?

The main purpose of the day centre at Milton Grange is providing inclusive and stimulating activities to a wide range of clients with Mental Health needs, whilst carrying out some personal care.

What skills do I need? The top 3 skills for this post are:

1. Good verbal and written communication skills
2. An ability to liaise and work co-operatively with others
3. Organised – able to follow a plan of action e.g., a client's support plan

What attributes do I need for this post?

To be highly motivated, enthusiastic and dedicated with a keen interest in developing your skills and knowledge further.

What knowledge do I need for this post?

At the application and interview stage it would be useful for you to: -

1. Demonstrate an awareness of working with people with complex mental health needs OR a willingness to develop this knowledge
2. Not essential but some knowledge of safeguarding vulnerable adults would be useful
3. Not essential but an awareness of the [mental capacity act](#) would be useful

What experience do I need?

You don't need any experience; a full training programme is provided. However, the team is looking for candidates with experience in using IT and an understanding of medication administration procedures is *desirable* as the role will include the day-to-day management of medication.



What else does the job offer?

- 37 hours per week
- A mix of shifts – weekends, early and late shifts
- Paid holiday plus bank holidays
- Full induction and training and progression opportunities
- Regular mentoring/supervision
