### Headlines - May 2022

Duty to participate at academic age 16 for May22 was 91.4%, compared to 94.1% in May21 and 92.7% in May20

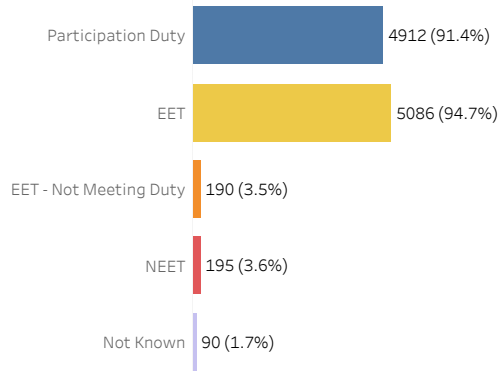
Duty to participate at academic age 17 for May22 was 84.1%, compared to 88.4% in May21 and 85.5% in May20

2.0% of our 16 & 17 year-olds are recorded as Not Known, higher than 1.7% in May21 and 1.7% in May20

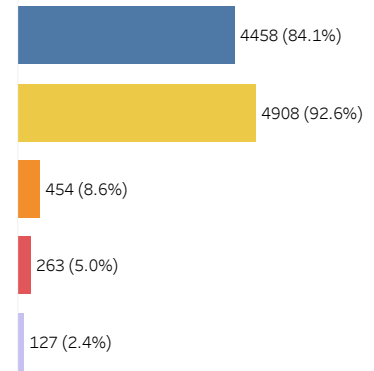
16 & 17yr olds who are NEET has now reduced to below pre-COVID levels from 5.2% in May20 to 4.3% in May22

The reduction in those participating is due to a significant increase in those entering employment without training; up 87% since May last year

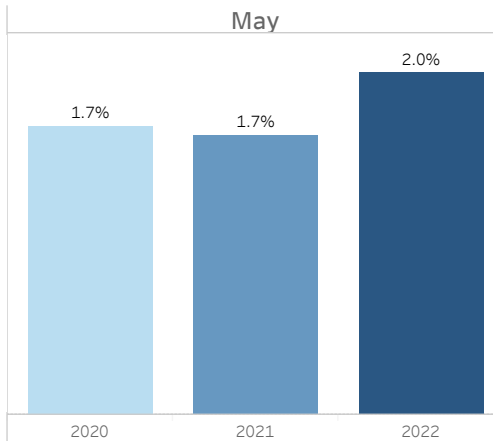


#### Academic Age 17 Cohort Total: 5,299

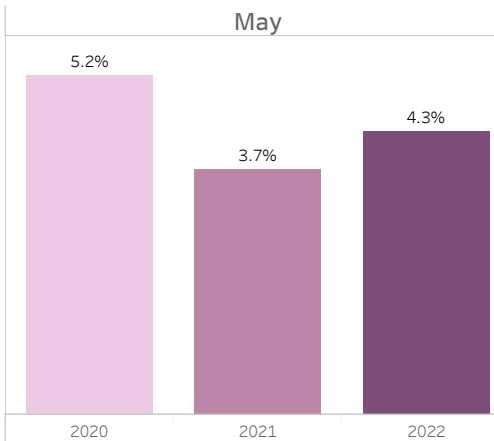

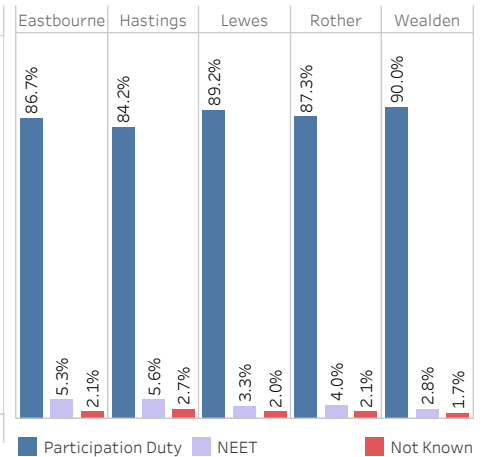

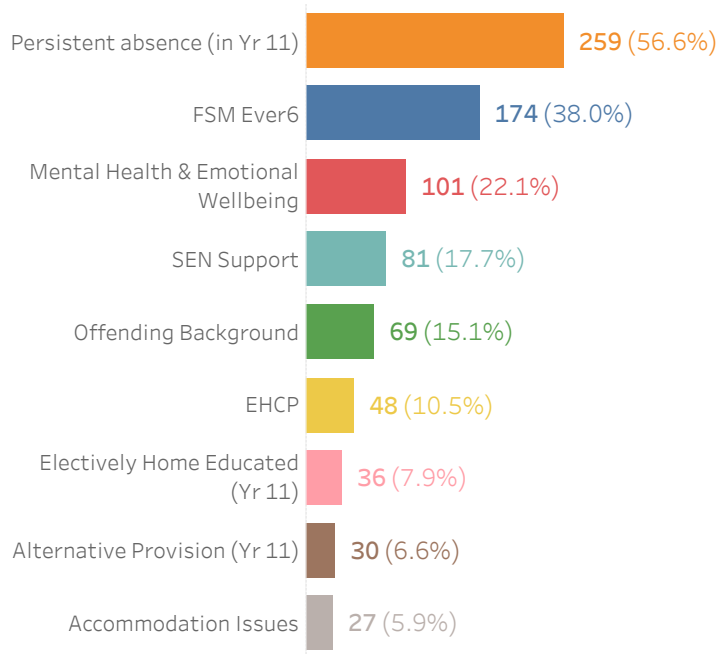
### NEETs per Year Group

(with % of year group NEET)

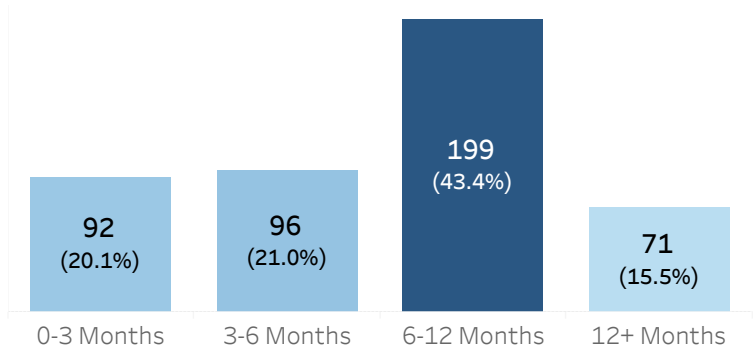


### Top Individual Circumstances

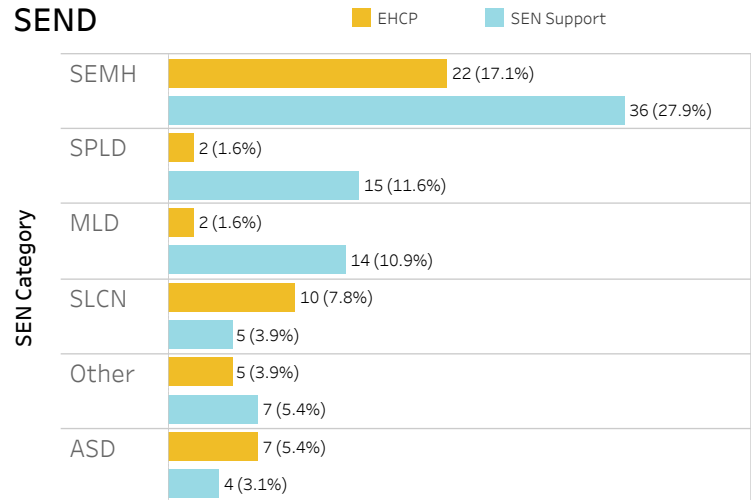

### Most recent LA comparison data for East Sussex (Apr 2022)

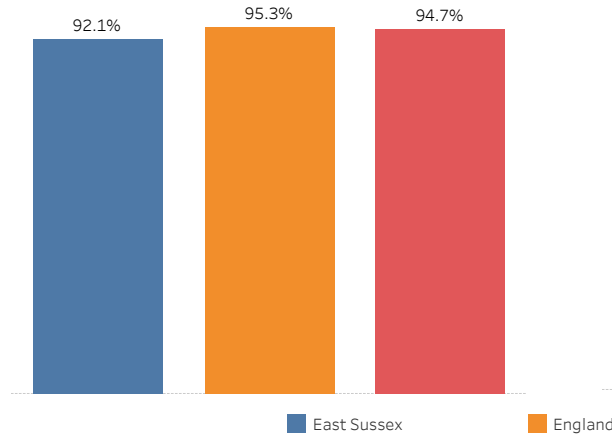
Participation duty at 16yrs was 92.1%, below national at 95.3% and south east at 94.7%

Participation duty at 17yrs was 84.7%, below national at 90.3% and south east at 89.2%

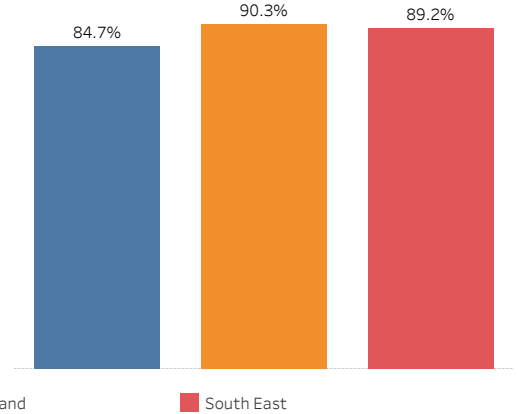
Not known at 16yrs was 1.0%, better than national at 1.1% and significantly better than south east at 1.7%

Not known at 17yrs was 2.0%, significantly better than national at 2.7% and significantly better than south east at 3.5%

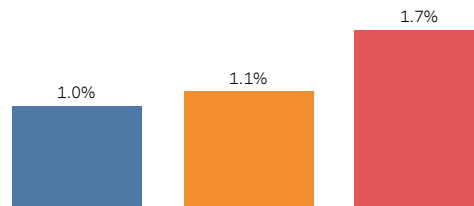
Participation % - Academic Age 16



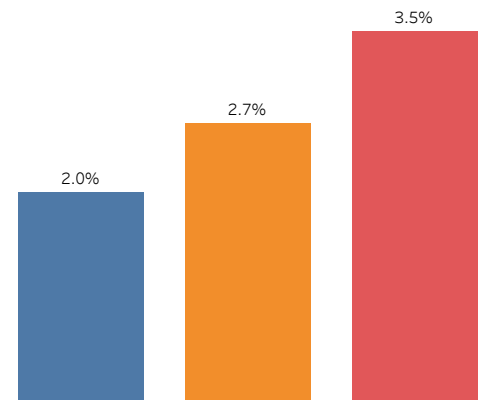
Participation % - Academic Age 17

## Explanatory Notes

### **Participation Key Indicators:**

#### **Participation Duty** includes:

- Full time education
- Apprenticeship
- Employment with accredited training
- Self-employment with accredited training
- Working not for reward with accredited training
- EFA/SFA funded Work Based Learning
- Other Training (e.g. : private training organisations)
- Traineeship
- Supported internship
- Gap Year
- Re-engagement (classified as 'Working Towards' the Duty)
- NEET – Start date agreed Participation Compliant (Working Towards)
- NEET young people on Youth Contract – those who are Seeking EET or Not yet ready for work or learning (Working Towards)

#### **Please note:** 'Participation duty' does not include:

- Part time education
- Employment without training
- Employment with non-accredited training
- Temporary employment
- Part time employment

(Additional information: The term 'In Learning' or 'Participating in education and training' is sometimes used by the DfE and this is 'Participation Duty' excluding Gap year & Working Towards but including part-time education)

### **SEN Support:**

A learner with a learning difficulty or disability which calls for special educational provision to be made for them, but whose needs do not meet the criteria for an EHC plan.

ASD - Autistic Spectrum Disorder  
EBD - Emotional Behavioural Difficulty  
MLD - Moderate Learning Difficulty  
MSI - Multi-Sensory Impairment  
Other - Any other category  
PD - Physical Disability  
PD - Profound & Multiple Learning Difficulty  
SEMH - Social, Emotional & Mental Health  
SPLD - Specific Learning Difficulty  
SLCN - Speech, Language & Communication Needs  
VI - Visual Impairment

### **Mental Health & Emotional Wellbeing Flag:**

This is down to the discretion of the advisor working with the young person

### **Persistent Absence (Year 11):**

Absence of 10% or more during Year 11. For the current Year 13 cohort (2020 statutory education leavers), this information is available only for the autumn term.
